Contents

The training aims at providing staff of NGOs engaged in conflict areas with the skills to apply the do no harm-approach when managing their projects.

- ⇒ How to conduct a Do no harm-analysis?
- ⇒ How to combine Do no harm with other project management tools?
- ⇒ How to integrate Do no harm into the project cycle and in your organisation?

This is not a training of trainers in which you learn how to teach others what Do no harm is! **In this training you practice how to apply the Do no harm-approach** in the planning, monitoring and evaluation stage of your projects. We offer different formats for respective application workshops.

We will reflect on our experiences in applying do no harm in combination with other project management tools – be it small tools like actor mapping or more comprehensive ones like the logframe.

We don't see Do no harm as the one and only tool! Instead we will reflect and share lessons learned how Do no harm could be integrated into the toolbox that is used in your organisation already.

Logistics

The training starts on Thursday, 9th of September 2010 at 2 p.m. and ends on Wednesday, 15th of September 2010 at noon. The nearest train stations are Uelzen (from Hannover) or Salzwedel (from Berlin).

The training fee includes training material, food and lodging at the training venue of KURVE Wustrow (in dormitory style).
